The Board of Directors of the Enchantment Home Owner's Association would like to commend Jackpot Painting, Inc. as a sub-contractor of The G.B. Group, General Contractors. Excellent results were obtained from your company in painting the twenty residential buildings and the pool equipment building.

The preparation work was outstanding, starting with the power washing of the building exteriors, scraping and wire brushing all peeling paint. Then repairing the damaged stucco surfaces with "Thoroscal" waterproofing stucco patch and filling stucco cracks with acrylic/urethane sealant and top coat with "Custom Patch".

Our condominium complex borders a golf course and several buildings have had their share of golf ball strikes. One of the unexpected results of your applying the Nationwide Ultra Seal Satin Ceramic Insulating Elastomeric paint was that the damage from the golf balls striking the buildings was minimized. Apparently there is enough elasticity in the paint that when the golf balls strike a building, they bounce off without penetrating the stucco. This will save the Association a considerable amount of money by not having to pay for stucco repairs caused by the golf ball strikes.


In the future, should your company desire a favorable reference, we would be happy to provide one.


